

Questions for audio material for local authorities:
Capturing voices of migrants in Cities

Possible Questions
1. Which ministry or local authority is in charge of receiving migrants in your city?
2. In your national level policies, what different legal status can migrants have? Which are the ones that are most common in your city?
3. What are the policies, strategies or resources in place to guide migration in the city?
4. What are the processes/activities offered for including or integrating migrants?
5. What housing schemes are provided for migrants? (Is there support for migrants looking for housing?)
6. How do you inform the public on migration related topics (in order to avoid xenophobia)?
7. What are the most tangible impacts of migration on the city?
8. What measures are in place to protect migrants?
9. How do you collaborate with private sector or civil society for migrant inclusion and social cohesion?
10. How do you deal with transportation, sanitation and safety issues with regards to migration?
11. What draws migrants to your city?
12. How has migration impacted urbanization in the city?
13. What measures are in place to prevent urban sprawl or increase in informal settlements?
14. Are migrants included in your basic service delivery plan?
15. Can migrants acquire land or property? (Do they need to have a specific legal status for this?)
16. What initiatives are in place that create employment opportunities for migrants?
17. What approaches do you use to include migrants into (multi-cultural) planning or activities at the city level?
