

The forum is in line with UN-Habitat's National Urban Forum framework that promote inclusive discussions towards improving Malaysia's urbanization strategies, policies, programs and actions and includes the participation of local, regional and national governments as well as stakeholders that supports the sustainable urban agenda.













Malaysia Urban Forum

This year we are transforming MUF2020 into a 'hybrid conference' – an interactive virtual platform and physical meeting. The event will be a milestone for Malaysia as it will be one of the countries that is organising an Urban Forum during global pandemic in the 'New Normal', with an estimated 30,000 entries included virtually from local and international representatives as well as general visitors.

The Malaysia Urban Forum will be held this year at Bangunan Sulaiman, Kuala Lumpur from 28 - 30 September 2020. The urban matters to be discussed include but are not limited to urban innovation and technologies, urban farming, age-friendly cities, public space, climate change, community wellbeing and recovery planning. Stakeholders of the cities includes from NGO representatives, mayors, scholars, professionals and public of all ages from all around the world and Malaysia are coming together on the same platform with a target audience of 10,000, the Forum are comprised of pre-event labs, high-level dialogues, special, side events, urban labs and virtual exhibition.

With Malaysia Urban Forum, Urbanice Malaysia aims to establish an urban forum to be annually organized at national level. will bring together all the stakeholders that play an important role in the design, transformation and management of cities, and different approaches to urban services and city management will be addressed together. The forum will provide the basis for sharing knowledge, experience and opportunities with more than 200 speakers from different countries and 10,000 participants virtually.

MUF2020 aims to strengthen the role of local governments and cities in crises and pandemic situation for various reasons, to raise awareness on safe, inclusive, resilient and sustainable urbanization, to contribute to the transformation of cities to make them more liveable and equitable, to provide information flow between cities and city-regions and support networks of relations between cities.
